We \underline{do} authorize and pay overdrafts for any of the following types of transaction s.

(Upon officer approval)

- Checks and other transactions made using your checking account number.
- Automatic bill payments

We do not authorize and pay overdrafts for any of the following types of transactions unless you ask us to (see below):

- *ATM transactions, including cash withdrawals and transfers between accounts.
- *Everyday debit card transactions, such as purchasing items at a store.

*Unless you have chosen to opt in for these types of transactions that would create an overdraft on your account, the se transactions will be declined at the time they are initiated.

We pay overdrafts at our discretion, which means we <u>do not guarantee</u> that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction.

If we do not authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be declined.

What fees will I be charged if American Exchange Bank pays my overdraft?

• We will charge you a fee of \$25.00.
